 2. Composition such as Story, Essay Writing and Letter Writing (10 marks)
- This task will involve the production of a discursive text in which the student is required to express his or her point of view on the topic.

Section C: Grammar

1. Grammar based on ‘The New Grammar Tree- 6’ (15 marks)
2. Grammar in use word power reference skills, communication and integrated grammar based on ‘Main Course Book’ (05 marks)

Section D: Text Books:

Part A: Course book

Four suitable questions from ‘Answer in brief’ or „Answer in detail“ based on Prose texts or Poems from the ‘Main Course book’ to be asked. The students are expected to answer in 30 to 40 words. (4× 2=8 marks)

Part B: Literature Reader

One extract from different poems from the prescribed **Literature Reader** text book, each followed by two or three questions each extract will carry 2 marks (2 × 1=2 marks)

Five short answer type questions of interpretative or evaluative or factual in nature. Each question is to carry 2 marks. The students are expected to answer in 30 to 40 words. Only those questions given in Literature Reader will be asked.

(5 × 2 = 10 Marks)

All topics appearing in ‘Course **Book and Literature Reader**’ are to be taught in detail.
