Part B: Raintree English Literature Reader

One extract from different poems from the prescribed text book, each followed by two or three questions each extract will carry 2 marks (2 × 1=2 marks)

Five short answer type questions of interpretative or evaluative or factual in nature. Each question is to carry 2 marks. The students are expected to answer in 30 to 40 words. Only those questions given in Literature Reader will be asked. (5 × 2 = 10 Marks).

All topics appearing in ‘**Seashore English Course book and Raintree English Literature Reader**’ are to be taught in detail.
